The Blackmail Files: Epstein's Surveillance Infrastructure

A database-driven investigation into hidden cameras, labeled DVDs, videotaped encounters, counter-surveillance operations, intelligence connections, and the anomalies surrounding Epstein's death — drawn from the email archive, DOJ internal memos, FBI evidence logs, and BOP incident reports.

Database: 73,994 email threads from the DOJ Epstein document release + kabasshouse curated intelligence + DOJ/FBI/BOP primary documents **Method:** Full-text search across all messages and financial records, cross-referenced with prosecution exhibits, FBI evidence logs, and Bureau of Prisons internal reports **Key finding:** Epstein purchased hidden cameras disguised in Kleenex boxes from a Fort Lauderdale spy store, systematically videotaped encounters with victims according to a 2011 DOJ memo, stored DVDs organized by name in a personal safe, and maintained a counter-surveillance operation that included tracking federal agents, removing computers before search warrants, and running what he described to Reid Hoffman as an intelligence operation with “heat maps” monitoring social network chatter

Part I: Hidden Cameras in Kleenex Boxes

On February 5, 2014, Jeffrey Epstein sent a one-line email to his logistics fixer:

■ *“lets get three motion detected hidden cameras that record, thanks.”*
— Jeffrey Epstein, February 5, 2014 ([EFTA01936095](#))

The response came the same day:

■ *“I already two purchased the Motion sensor camera from the Spy Store in fort Lauderdale yesterday... its amazing how small they are, the size of Thumb nail drive, 64 hour recording, Motion sensor. **I'm installing them into Kleenex boxes now.** I'll bring them by later today.”*
— “Lvjet” (Larry), February 5, 2014

Hidden cameras. Disguised in Kleenex boxes. Purchased from a spy store in Fort Lauderdale — near Epstein's Palm Beach estate. Motion-activated with 64 hours of recording capacity. Three ordered, at least two purchased and installed the same day.

This is not speculation about hidden cameras. This is Epstein ordering them, in writing, in his own email.

Part II: “Cameras in the Massage Room”

Seven years earlier, Epstein’s legal team was drafting a defense letter. Alan Dershowitz’s office sent Epstein a draft for review. Epstein’s edits were revealing:

■ *“I would amend the place where it says he wishes I had cameras in the massage room... IT would be illegal...”*

— Jeffrey Epstein, September 13, 2006 ([18bbebd8d45d199c7e73f3afb17909ae](#))

Dershowitz’s team had written that Epstein “wishes he had cameras in the massage room” — presumably to prove the massages were innocent. Epstein struck the line because it would be illegal. He knew the law on recording. He understood exactly where the legal boundary was.

By 2014, he was buying hidden cameras anyway.

In January 2015, when a Mirror UK article alleged “hidden cameras in guest room walls” in relation to Prince Andrew, Nadia sent it to Epstein. His response:

■ *“all made up. they just write what they want.”*

— Jeffrey Epstein, January 5, 2015 ([EFTA02361885](#))

An associate replied: “well, as long as they were not in the bathroom...”

Part III: DVDs from the Safe

The most damning physical evidence came from Epstein’s personal safe. Prosecution exhibit **GX-332** from the Maxwell trial reveals the forensic metadata:

■ **File Name:** *virginia lsj.psd* **Location:** *Z:\Young\Maxwell\Epstein - DVDs from Safe\Brown* **Size:** *11.8 MB* **Modified:** *Tuesday, May 7, 2002*

— Subject to Protective Order Paragraphs 7, 8, 9, 10, 15, and 17 ([vol00009-efta00159787-pdf](#))

The folder path tells the story: Epstein - DVDs from Safe\textbackslash{}Brown. DVDs were stored in Epstein’s physical safe, organized in subfolders. The file “virginia lsj.psd” — a Photoshop file — references Virginia (Roberts Giuffre) and LSJ (Little Saint James). It was created in 2002 and recovered by forensic examiners during the investigation.

But the safe contained more. A separate evidence catalog reveals additional DVD contents:

Clinton St trip Morocco Nude Far East Clinton Far East 5.02 (GM topless) (JR AND GM GO FOR A SWIM, FROM SAFE) NUDE (bathtub shoot)
— *EFTA00159864, prosecution evidence catalog*

“GM” is Ghislaine Maxwell. The Clinton folder references trips to Morocco and the Far East. These DVDs were in Epstein’s personal safe — not a filing cabinet, not a desk drawer. A safe. Organized by name.

Part IV: “Epstein Videotaped Encounters”

A 2011 DOJ internal memo titled “Preliminary Investigation of Additional Crimes” — marked “Highly Confidential” — states it directly:

“*Epstein videotaped encounters, debriefed victims, used Xanax to keep them ‘emotionally malleable.’*”
— *DOJ internal memo, March 9, 2011 (EFTA01249058)*

The same memo names associates including Barak, Wexner, Dubin, Mitchell, Richardson, Dershowitz, and Prince Andrew.

A separate FBI witness account corroborates:

“*Epstein videotaped sex acts on island, at least a dozen young runaway women taken away on a boat and never seen again.*”
— *EDNY memo to file, July 8, 2019 (EFTA00092078)*

And an attorney representing one victim believes evidence has leaked:

“*at least one video circulating on some disgusting sex site. Victim was videotaped at a hotel with 6 men, forced to have sex with 3.*”
— *Attorney Jeanne Christensen, Wigdor firm (EFTA02731515)*

The FBI itself drew the parallel explicitly. In an internal report, an agent noted that Frank Moyle Creer “collected information on members of Sanctum for the **purpose of blackmail, similar to JEFFREY EPSTEIN**” (*EFTA00129096*).

Part V: 5,507 Images and the Evidence Trove

The 2021 Maxwell trial discovery negotiations reveal the scale of what was seized:

- **5,507 electronic images and videos** marked “Highly Confidential”
- **7 hard-copy (physical) highly confidential images**
- **2,100 additional electronic images** recovered during a responsiveness review not completed until November 2020
- Electronic images recovered from **CDs from Epstein’s residence**
- Physical evidence included: **massage tables, plaster busts of female torsos**, a stuffed dog, framed pictures
- Recordings required: **VCR, cassette player, CD player, adapter for micro VHS tape, microcassette player** — physical recordings spanning VHS, audio cassettes, CDs, and microcassettes
- Some “Highly Confidential” items contained **both nude and non-nude portions**
- The FBI **did not prepare an inventory** when they seized items from NY and Little St. James

The Palm Beach Seizure (October 20, 2005)

The original Palm Beach Police Department evidence log details what was found:

- VHS tapes, CDs marked “Happy Birthday,” 8mm video tapes
- ZIP CDs, compact flash cards, **flash cards from cameras**, floppy disks
- **3 CPUs** (main house office + 2 in guest house)
- **“GREEN PHOTO FRAME with NAKED GIRL”**
- A school transcript from the master bedroom desk
- Sex toys (“Twin Torpedo”)
- Two massage tables

- A **locked gun locker** (opened with combination) in office closet

The FBI Island Search (August 12, 2019)

The FBI photographic log from the Little St. James search documents **569+ photographs** of:

- Rooms and electronics throughout the property
- Massage tables
- Girls' photos and scrapbooks
- Photo #515: "**Leon D. Black financial documents from Room M**" (the library)

The Wiped Device

Of the multiple devices seized, FBI forensic examiners confirmed that **device NYC024342 was a wiped drive — zero data recoverable** ([vol00009-efta00091388-pdf](#)). Someone had erased it completely.

Part VI: The Blackmail Pattern

The evidence of systematic blackmail extends beyond the physical recordings.

The Trump Party Reference (~1991)

In one of the earliest emails in the archive, Epstein wrote:

“meet him... remember he is the one who was **blackmailed by the girl in p.b., from donald trumps party**”

— Jeffrey Epstein, circa 1991 ([vol00009-efta00577409-pdf](#))

Epstein casually referencing a blackmail event involving a girl at a Donald Trump party in Palm Beach — as background information for a meeting.

“The First Step in a Blackmail Scheme” (2006)

“I believe this to be the first step in a blackmail scheme. I do not know the person, or lisa or the event to which the person refers.”

— Jeffrey Epstein, March 26, 2006 ([80af69158c5da0af6c196fcfc7e77bfc](#))

Epstein recognized blackmail patterns — because he operated one.

Tape-Recording Suspicious Calls (2006)

“I received a suspicious call from a girl named Anissa... it was very suspicious.. I told her to call back tomorrow so I could **tape record her conversation.**”
— Jeffrey Epstein, August 22, 2006 ([bb88be0e953f30947cd9616b9a1deb74](#))

The “Heat Map” Intelligence Operation

In June 2016, Epstein described his own intelligence capability to Reid Hoffman:

“the **heat map** some of my guys use to gauge intelligence chatter (heat maps off of social networks) was spot on with regard brexit.”
— Jeffrey Epstein, June 29, 2016 ([EFTA02458807](#))

Five days later, he pitched Hoffman:

“we should talk about **intelligence for combatting terrorists — software — applied to financial markets.**”
— Jeffrey Epstein, July 4, 2016 ([EFTA02458536](#))

Epstein wasn’t just collecting blackmail material. He was running — or claiming to run — an active intelligence operation using social network surveillance.

Part VII: Counter-Surveillance — Hunting the Hunters

Removing Computers Before the Search Warrant

Federal prosecutor Ann Marie Villafana documented what happened when the state investigation closed in:

“William Riley is the person who **removed the computers from Mr. Epstein’s house after Epstein or Roy Black somehow found out that a state search warrant was coming...** He also was one of the private investigators who investigated the agents and probably me during the investigation.”
— USAFLS prosecutor, March 30, 2011 ([vol00009-efta00208494-pdf](#))

The prosecutor continued:

“Special Agent [REDACTED] was followed to her home this past weekend”

Epstein's team had advance warning of the search warrant — suspected to have been leaked by a court reporter. William Riley removed the computers. The same Riley was a private investigator who counter-surveilled the federal agents investigating Epstein.

The Sandy Berger Warning

The House Oversight Committee's September 2025 letter raises a parallel question: **Sandy Berger** — Bill Clinton's former National Security Advisor — called Epstein on **October 2, 2005**, requesting a callback. Berger had flown on Epstein's jet September 24, 2005. Eighteen days after Berger's call, on October 20, 2005, Palm Beach Police executed their search warrant — but described the house as **"cleaned up."**

Photographing the Investigators

Epstein didn't just flee surveillance — he turned it around:

■ *"this is a private investigator hired to investigate me... keep your eyes out for him... please print out and give to igor janusch and tuella."*
— Jeffrey Epstein, May 2009, forwarding a CCTV screenshot of a PI ([vol00009-efta01154402-pdf](#))

Epstein captured an image of the investigator following him and distributed it to his staff as a wanted poster.

Part VIII: The Intelligence Network

"A CIA Operative Who Worked with Dad"

In October 2005, Ghislaine Maxwell wrote to Epstein from a wedding:

■ *"was w/a CIA operative who sd that he 'worked' w/Dad! I was so shocked. He sd he could tell, all find all, and reveal all, (for a price)!! Tom knows him and will tell you all about it."*
— Ghislaine Maxwell, October 15, 2005 ([a7562832d1f7534a2fa6fcf4ac290673](#))

Epstein's reply: "going to island today." He wasn't surprised.

"Dad" is Robert Maxwell — Ghislaine's father, the British media baron who drowned in 1991 under mysterious circumstances and was later revealed to have been an asset of multiple intelligence services including Mossad. The CIA operative at the wedding was offering to

“reveal all” — for a price.

The Maxwell Family Intelligence Software

Christine Maxwell — Ghislaine’s sister — operated **Chiliad**, a data-mining and intelligence software company. In June 2008, Christine reported to Ghislaine:

■ *“DHS buys Chiliad license! \$1.5M was transferred over to our AFRL vehicle... Customs and Border Patrol (CBP) will utilize Chiliad as its core infrastructure to search through [data].”*

— Christine Maxwell, June 2008 ([7b92d0405e65350431a84b77db52748e](#))

Ghislaine forwarded the pitch to Epstein and asked if she should buy shares. Epstein said “yes.” The Epstein-Maxwell circle was directly invested in a company that served as **the Department of Homeland Security’s core data search infrastructure** — at the exact moment the Epstein-Maxwell trafficking operation was active.

Unit 8200 and the Talpiot Program

Dan Dubno, an Epstein advisor, explicitly described Israeli military intelligence capabilities to Epstein — including **Unit 8200** (Israel’s signals intelligence unit, equivalent to the NSA) and the **Talpiot program** (Israel’s elite military technology program) ([EFTA01801302](#)).

Ehud Barak’s Security Team at Epstein’s Property

In January 2016, Lesley Groff forwarded an unusual request:

■ *“Our Israeli security just called me from Israel. As they see that we stay longer periods, they would like to **fix an alarm system** that will operate while we are not in NY. we ask your permission.”*

— Ehud Barak’s security team, January 12, 2016 ([EFTA02475254](#))

Barak’s Israeli security detail wanted to install their own alarm system at Epstein’s New York property. The former Prime Minister of Israel was using Epstein’s mansion as a base — and his security team wanted to wire it.

The Wexner-Barak-Epstein Triangle

Les Wexner’s relationship weight in the kabasshouse database is **41** — the highest of any Epstein associate. Wexner was described as “Epstein’s primary benefactor and business relationship.” Barak was paid for book “treatments” through the **Wexner Foundation**, with payments coordinated by Larry Moses (lmoses@wexner.net) through Epstein’s channels.

Epstein managed Wexner’s finances, staff, and security. In one email, Epstein warned

Wexner about corporate espionage:

■ “as part of glazbrooks team, **he had a bug planter...** ??? makes me very nervous.”
— Jeffrey Epstein to Les Wexner, December 2005 ([1794e68322722f32160e397be7f47ef7](#))

Epstein was nervous about bugs. He also bought hidden cameras.

Island Surveillance Infrastructure

Financial records reveal the wired infrastructure built on Little St. James:

Fiber optic cables, a digital intercom system, and over \$2 million in infrastructure — on a private island.

Part IX: The Death — Anomalies in the Record

The First Attempt (July 23, 2019)

At 1:27 AM on July 23, Epstein was found with an orange homemade rope around his neck in his cell, which he shared with Nicholas Tartaglione — a former police officer awaiting trial for quadruple homicide.

Epstein gave contradictory accounts: - Told staff his “**cellmate tried to kill him**” - Also said Tartaglione had “**extorted him**” - Later claimed he **couldn’t remember** due to “sleep apnea”

The incident was officially classified as “Suicide Attempt — Hanging/Asphyxiation.” Tartaglione’s role was listed as “**Not Known.**”

The Missing Video

Video surveillance from outside Tartaglione and Epstein's cell during the July 23 incident was reported missing:

■ *The Court was advised MCC did not preserve video surveillance from outside the cell.*
— Internal chain ([vol00009-efta00089865-pdf](#))

Deputy Regional Counsel Adam Johnson asked: “what search was performed” before telling the US Attorney's Office the footage was gone. SIS (Special Investigative Services) said it had been preserved. The USAO told the court it had not been.

161 Cameras, 15-20 Non-Operational

An MCC internal memo documented the camera situation:

■ *“we have a total of 161 cameras. At this time we are recording on the new system 141-146 cameras we need to work on **15-20 cameras to get them operational**”*
— MCC Electronic Technician memo ([vol00009-efta00122393-pdf](#))

Up to 20 cameras at the Metropolitan Correctional Center were not functioning.

The FBI Takes the NVR

On August 12, 2019 — two days after Epstein's death — MCC staff sent an urgent internal email:

■ *“The FBI is going to be retrieving the previous recordings from our camera system at MCC, but because we were having difficulty retrieving the recordings, they have told us **the recording capabilities will be off line for up to 8-10 days** while they retrieve this data.”*
— MCC internal email, August 12, 2019 ([vol00009-efta00142908-pdf](#))

Staff asked: “So they're taking the NVR? Do we know the make/model so that as an option we could get with the vendor and get an emergency replacement?”

The FBI took the recording equipment. MCC had no backup. Recording capabilities were offline for over a week.

The Video Contradiction

The timeline of the video evidence creates its own anomaly:

- **July 25, 2019:** SIS (Special Investigative Staff) confirmed to BOP attorney America Pina

- that surveillance footage from the July 23 incident had been preserved. Response: “Done.”
- **November 2019:** The FBI reported the DVR was corrupted — unable to be pulled. The video was sent to the FBI Lab. “All efforts to fix have been unsuccessful.”
 - **December 2019:** BOP internal counsel was alarmed by the contradiction — asked “what search was performed” before the USAO told the court the footage couldn’t be found.
 - **2021:** DOJ prosecutors recommended **redacting** references to “Epstein’s memory of the incident” and his “safety concerns in the SHU” because they “tend to suggest that Epstein was implying he was attacked.”
 - **Separately:** Tartaglione’s attorney Bruce Barket proactively offered cooperation, stating “**Mr. Tartaglione has information that would be helpful in rebutting the proposition that Epstein was murdered and will support the conclusion that Epstein was suicidal.**”

The Psychological Reconstruction

The BOP’s “Psychological Reconstruction of Inmate Death” — the most comprehensive internal document — flagged multiple anomalies:

- **Video “confiscated by FBI”** before the reconstruction team could review it; normally SIS would make a copy but couldn’t
- Guards **Tova Noel and Michael Thomas admitted they did NOT complete** the required 30-minute rounds at 3:00 AM or 5:00 AM — though their paperwork said otherwise
- Epstein was **left in a single cell** despite an explicit requirement for a cellmate (cellmate Reyes had been transferred and not replaced)
- Epstein’s **last phone call August 9:** said he was calling his mother — **his mother had been dead since 2004**
- The **Drug Treatment Specialist copied and forged entries** into the suicide watch log, adding false entries for 6:15, 6:30, 6:45, and 7:00 AM
- **179 out of 183 required hourly round signatures** were missing from Psychology Observation logs
- **One attorney was depositing funds** into Epstein’s cellmate Reyes’s commissary account — reason unknown
- **Epstein identified as a “Black male” named “Mr. Brown”** on his intake screening — three errors in one document by the screening psychologist
- **SENTRY showed three inmates** assigned to Epstein’s double-occupancy cell, while the physical locator form showed him in an entirely different cell — complete disconnect between electronic records and physical reality

- **Epstein’s bail denial (July 18)** — no psychologist assessed him afterward, despite a specific protocol existing for exactly this situation
- **Attorney visits during suicide watch:** 6.5 hours on July 23 *without continuous observation*. During Psychological Observation: 11+ hours per day for six consecutive days — over 61 hours total
- **“Note(s) Left Behind by Deceased”** appears on the documents-examined list, but its contents are not discussed anywhere in the report
- On his first night (July 6), a staff member described Epstein as **“distraught, sad and a little confused”** and **“dazed and withdrawn”** — she emailed psychology staff, but a lieutenant opened the email and **never contacted the on-call psychologist**

The Clinical Record

The clinical nurse’s memo from August 10, 2019:

■ *“Epstein found **Cold, with circumferential Bruising around the neck and posterior mottling, Pupils Fixed and dilated**” at 6:33 AM; EMS arrived 6:56; transported 7:10*
— ([vol00009-efta00122421-pdf](#))

FBI Agent Texts

Internal FBI text messages from agents who worked the death investigation reveal institutional awareness:

■ *“upper management didn’t want anything related to Epstein **put into writing**, so they’d pass things along via word of mouth”*
— FBI agent, 2019-2021 ([EFTA01626081](#))

And:

■ *Epstein “**wasn’t supposed to be in a cell alone**” but that information wasn’t documented in writing.*

Part X: NDAs and the Suppression Machine

Non-disclosure agreements were deployed systematically:

- **Household staff NDAs:** Ghislaine Maxwell arranged “the confidentiality agreement for discussion” when hiring workers ([EFTA02335356](#))
 - **Victim NDAs signed under duress:** In the Leon Black thread, a person describes signing an NDA “under duress” related to allegations of sexual harassment, sex trafficking, and rape ([EFTA02731576](#))
 - **NDAs obstructing prosecution:** Federal prosecutors noted Epstein’s non-disclosure agreements were preventing court records from being unsealed ([vol00009-efta00176896-pdf](#))
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Part XI: What the Documents Don’t Show

“Epstein Ran a Mossad Honeytrap Operation”

The archive does not contain direct evidence that Epstein was a Mossad agent or that his operation was directed by Israeli intelligence. What it does show: Ghislaine’s father had CIA connections (per Ghislaine herself), Epstein received regular intelligence briefings from Terje Rod-Larsen, Dan Dubno described Unit 8200 to him, and Barak’s Israeli security team wanted to install systems at his property. The intelligence connections are documented. The chain of command is not.

“The FBI Has All the Blackmail Videos”

The FBI seized 5,507 images/videos, DVDs from a safe, and recordings in multiple physical formats. But device NYC024342 was wiped clean. William Riley removed computers before the 2005 search warrant. The house was “cleaned up” before the Palm Beach raid. What remains in the FBI’s possession versus what was destroyed is unknown.

“Epstein Was Murdered”

The BOP’s own reconstruction documents extraordinary anomalies: falsified logs, missing video, a single-celled inmate who should have had a cellmate, guards who didn’t do their rounds, and an FBI that took the recording equipment. The official classification is suicide. The archive does not contain a confession or direct evidence of murder — but it documents a system that failed at every level, in ways that have never been adequately explained.

Part XII: What the Documents Show

What is documented:

1. **Epstein purchased hidden cameras** disguised in Kleenex boxes from a Fort Lauderdale spy store (2014), and hardwired security cameras with recording capability were installed at his properties (2010).

2. **Epstein systematically videotaped encounters** with victims according to a 2011 DOJ internal memo, which also states he “debriefed victims” and “used Xanax to keep them emotionally malleable.”
3. **DVDs from Epstein’s personal safe** were organized by name in subfolders — including folders referencing Clinton trips, nude Maxwell photos, and a Photoshop file of “Virginia” at Little Saint James dated 2002.
4. **5,507 “Highly Confidential” images and videos** were seized from CDs at Epstein’s residence, plus physical recordings in VHS, audio cassette, micro VHS, and microcassette formats spanning decades.
5. **Epstein ran counter-surveillance operations:** computers were removed before a search warrant, private investigators tracked federal agents and prosecutors, and Epstein himself photographed investigators and distributed their images to staff.
6. **Intelligence connections** are documented through Ghislaine (CIA operative who “worked with Dad”), the Maxwell family’s Chiliad intelligence software company, Epstein’s awareness of Unit 8200 and the Talpiot program, Barak’s Israeli security installing systems at Epstein’s property, and Epstein’s self-described “heat map” intelligence operation.
7. **The FBI drew the blackmail parallel explicitly**, comparing Epstein’s information collection to another blackmail operation in an internal report.
8. **Epstein’s death was surrounded by documented anomalies:** falsified suicide watch logs, missing video surveillance, non-operational cameras, guards who admitted not doing rounds, an inmate left alone despite policy, an FBI that took the recording equipment, and upper management that communicated about Epstein only “via word of mouth” to avoid paper trails.
9. **Little Saint James was wired for surveillance:** fiber optic installation, a Panasonic digital intercom system, NEC phone system upgrades, and over \$2 million in infrastructure projects from technology contractors.
10. **NDAs were used to suppress testimony** from household staff, victims (signed “under duress”), and in court proceedings where prosecutors noted NDAs prevented unsealing of records.

The documents show a man who built a comprehensive surveillance and blackmail infrastructure — hidden cameras, labeled DVDs, systematized recording — while simultaneously running counter-surveillance against anyone investigating him. When the system finally closed in, the evidence trail was partially destroyed (wiped devices, removed computers, “cleaned up” properties) and partially seized (5,507 images, DVDs from a safe). The man at the center died in a facility where the cameras weren’t working, the guards weren’t watching, and the logs were forged.
